The per cent of attendance was unusually high during the year which shows the parents are interested in having their children attend school regularly.

Seventeen pupils have attended high school in other towns during the year.

Teachers and pupils have worked to earn money to improve their schools. At Hanksville they have bought paint for side walls; also a new oil stove. At the Center a much needed encyclopedia has been purchased. A cupboard for

lunches has been placed in the primary room of the C. E. R. school. The P. T. A. bought a victrola for the grammar room. The teachers of the C. E. R. school plan to buy a few movable desks during the year. All the teachers have purchased work books in some subjects which have added to the interest of the pupils and the efficiency of the work.

We have bought books with the idea of having uniform texts in three schools. This has not always been done and as a result the texts in the schools are not the same in many subjects.

I think that excellent work has been done by the teachers and hope the same teachers may be engaged for next year.
