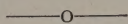

## REPORT OF THE SUPERINTENDENT OF SCHOOLS

To the Voters of the Town of Huntington:

Herewith is submitted my third annual report as superintendent of schools.

The following schools have been maintained during the year for a period of 35 weeks as required by law:

Catherine Ross, grades 1-4 .....	41
Catherine Ross, grades 5-8 .....	27
Center School .....	23
Hanksville School .....	19

On account of sickness the per cent of attendance will not be as high as usual this year. Since the amount of State Aid returned to the towns is determined largely by the average daily attendance it is very important that there be as few absences as possible.

Transportation cost has increased somewhat during the past year as it has been necessary to transport the children of families living some distance from the schools. The cost of transporting 35 elementary school pupils was \$623.50 or \$19.48 per pupil. This is much less than it is in many towns.

At the beginning of the current school year two new teachers were engaged to fill vacancies in the Hanksville and Center schools. Miss Rena Guilmette and Miss Irene Vondle were engaged to fill the vacancies in these schools. Both teachers are doing satisfactory work in their respective positions.

To meet the requirements of the new State Course of Study in History and Geography some new texts were necessary in these subjects. The new texts which were adopted last year are being used also to meet the required revision of the new courses.

Very little repairing of school buildings has been necessary during the past year. On account of increased enrollments in the Catherine Ross and Center Schools some new desks were necessary. At the present time school property is in a very satisfactory condition. The retention of the Standard and Superior Plates is evidence that your schools meet the approval of the State Board of Education.

For the schools to be successful, the co-operation and support of parents and townspeople are necessary. These factors have done much in the past to help maintain good schools. It is hoped that the same loyalty may be continued in the future.

In conclusion I wish to express my sincere appreciation to the townspeople, members of the school board, and teachers for their united efforts and assistance in the management of school work.
