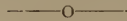

REPORT OF THE SUPERINTENDENT OF SCHOOLS

To the Voters of the Town of Huntington:

Herewith is submitted my fourth annual report as superintendent of schools.

As in previous years four schools have been maintained for a period of 35 weeks. The schools with enrollments are as follows:

Owing to the fact that several families with children of school age live at a considerable distance from the schools, the cost of transportation has increased during the past three years.

Forty-two pupils were transported during the past year at a cost of \$883.25 or \$21.03 per pupil.

It was necessary to engage one new teacher at the opening of the current school year. Miss Norma Shepard was

hired to fill the vacancy in the Hanksville School made by the resignation of Miss Rena Guilmette.

Few changes have been made in the courses of instruction. Some new texts have been added to supplement those introduced during the past few years.

A new course in health education has been added as required by law. To conduct this course properly some new books will be needed another year.

The physical condition of the children has been under the supervision of Miss Bogue R. N. Much improvement has been shown in the health of the children as a result of this assistance. The cost of maintaining health service has been borne by WPA.

The school buildings still continue in a very satisfactory condition. Very little repair work was necessary during the past year. It is hoped that this condition may be continued.

In conclusion may I commend the townspeople and parents for the support and cooperation which they have given during the past year. May I also express my appreciation to the members of the school board and teachers for their interest and assistance. It is through united efforts only that the continued success of the schools may be assured.
