## HUNTINGTON BICENTENNIAL 1763-1963

On October 12, 1963, the Town of Huntington celebrated the bicentennial anniversary of its founding on June 7, 1763. The celebration included a parade of floats reviewed by the Selectmen from the steps of the Town Hall, a field day with numerous athletic contests, a bear and beef barbecue, and an old-fashioned dance in the Town Hall, attended by the Governor of Vermont and his wife. Prior to a speech by the Governor, the Moderator read a congratulatory letter from U. S. Senator Aiken and the following message from the late President of the United States:

“The White House, Washington, D. C., 11 October 1963  
People of Huntington, Vermont:

I have learned with much pleasure that the Town of Huntington, Vermont, is celebrating today its 200th Anniversary. On this memorable occasion, I am happy to extend to the citizens of Huntington my warm greetings and good wishes. As you commemorate this historic event, you may recall with pride your long record of progress and achievement. May your future success reflect your past accomplishments.
