## WARNING FOR TOWN MEETING.

The legal voters of March meeting of the town of Moretown are hereby notified and warned to meet at the Town Hall in said town on the 1st day of March, 1910, at 10 o'clock, A. M., to transact the following business:

- Art. 1. To choose a Moderator.
- “ 2. To hear the report of the town officers and take proper action.
- “ 3. To elect all necessary town officers for the year ensuing.
- “ 4. To see what tax the town will vote to pay the current expenses of said town for year ensuing and to pay the indebtedness of the town.
- “ 5. To see if the town will vote to raise a sum of money in addition to the amount required by law to take advantage of the “State Aid Law” and if so how much.
- “ 6. To see if the town will vote to raise a certain sum of money in addition to what the law requires to be laid out on highways and if so how much.
- “ 7. To see if the town will vote to have all taxes paid into town treasury as provided by law.
- “ 8. Shall license be granted for the sale of intoxicating liquors in this town. ?
- “ 9. To see if the town will vote to pay the Moretown Military Band a certain sum of money and if so how much?
- “ 10. To do any other incidental business found necessary when met.
- “ 11. To see if the town will vote to raise \$25.00 per year in addition to that already voted for the support of the town Library.
