## WARNING FOR ANNUAL TOWN MEETING.

The legal voters of March meeting of the town of Moretown are hereby notified and warned to meet at the Town Hall, in Moretown Village, on the 5th day of March, 1912, at 10 o'clock, A. M., to transact the following business:

ART. 1. To choose a moderator.

ART. 2. To elect a town clerk.

ART. 3. To hear the report of the town officers, and to take proper action thereon.

ART. 4. To elect all proper and necessary town officers for the year ensuing.

ART. 5. To see if the town will vote to have the selectmen appoint one or two road commissioners according to Act 107, laws of 1910.

ART. 6. To see if the town will vote to contribute fifty dollars for the support of the town library.

ART. 7. To see if the town will vote a sum of money in addition to what the law requires to be laid out on highways to take advantage of the State Aid law, if so how much?

ART. 8. To see if the town will vote a sum of money in addition to what the law requires to be laid out on highways, if so how much?

ART. 9. To see whether the town will vote to pay the current expenses of said town for the year ensuing and to pay the indebtedness of said town.

ART. 10. To see if the town will vote to have all taxes paid into the treasury as provided by law.

ART. 11. To see if the town will vote to sell the old session laws.

ART. 12. Shall license be granted for the sale of intoxicating liquors in said town?

ART. 13. To see if the town will vote to have the selectmen purchase snow rollers.

ART. 14. To do any other incidental business found necessary when met.
